CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The cricket landscape is changing with most of this Council's responsibilities, as far as competitions go, having moved up the line to Western Zone. Our focus is now mostly on fielding representative teams and we are always on the lookout for more volunteers to help with that.

At this point I have to give a massive thanks to Greg Griffith who continues to lead our junior development program which culminates in selecting teams for the Youth Championships. Greg continues to play a major role in this program, arranging coaches for the teams, organising off season selection and training sessions and so on.

In Western Zone competitions, our teams have a strong season. Our Mens team won one of their two Twenty20 matches against Western Plains to improve on our previous season's efforts. Our Colts team won all 5 matches; two Twenty20s and three fifty over matches and our Under 16 boys split the Twenty20s and won both of their 50 over matches. We also won the Tremain-Copeland Cup for our performances on the Western Zone T20 day.

We continued to field teams in the Under 13s, Under 14s and Under 15s at the Youth Championships with all 3 teams finishing mid-table. Whilst at times some may question this competition, I see great benefits to our players as it will help their development by providing exposure to a higher level of competition than they would otherwise get at home.

On the home front, congratulations to Mudgee for firstly winning the Rod Hartas Trophy as well as the Western Zone Plate. Unfortunately they were knocked out in the Semi Final of the Country Plate by Cessock.

Thank you to all of the coaches of our teams this season, including Stephen Cain and Greg Innes, who coached our Colts team; Dan Brincat and Glenn McDonald who took the Under 16s, Garth Dean & Mike Mitchell in Under 15s, Josh Willcox and Andrew Larnach for coaching the Under 14s and Matt Fearnley and Bill Hall who took the Under 13s.

Thank you to my committee and all other volunteers across our Council who put in countless hours for their association or club. We need to continue to build our volunteer base to help keep our game as strong as possible in our local area. There is also a lot more of offer from Cricket NSW these days, as far as support goes, so if your Association is struggling please make sure you reach out.

Congratulations must go to all of the players from our area that made NSW Country teams this season. Cooper Brien was part of the NSW Bush Blues that played in the Australian Country Championships played in the Barossa Valley. Callee Black and Kira Churchland were part of the NSW Bush Breakers team.

Callee was also part of the Under 19s female team, along with Blayney's Ella Tilburg. Bathurst's Blayde Burke was our lone representative in the Under 19s male side. Blayde was also selected in the NSW Country Under 17 side, along with Cowra's Cooper Pullen who represents Central West and also played some club cricket in Orange when home from boarding school. Five of the Under 16 female side hail from our region, including Phoebe Johnston, Holly Reed and Simran Dhatt from Orange, along with Charlotte Shoemark and Poppi Stephen from Bathurst.

SEASON AWARDS

Andy Farley Shield - Senior Cricketer of the Year

Cooper Brien (Bathurst)



Following a short stint in NSW Premier Cricket with Western Suburbs, Cooper Brien returned home for season 2024/25.

The move proved to be a good one, as he gained selection in the NSW Country “Bush Blues” for the Australia Country Championships held in the Barossa Valley.

A member of the Western Zone side that made the final of both the McDonalds Country Championships and the Plan B Regional Bash, Cooper scored 246 runs at the Country Championships for Western Zone, at an average of 41.00 and including a top score of 116 against Greater Illawarra, to earn his place at the nationals.

While representing Bathurst, Cooper scored 2 centuries, helping his Bathurst side to the final of the Western Zone Premier League competition. On the home front, Cooper was part of the St Pats Old Boys side that won both the BOIDC Premiership and the ODCA’s BurMac Bonnor Cup T20 competition, also named player of the Bonnor Cup competition.

In his 39 matches across season 2024/25 Cooper scored 1372 runs at an average of 45.73, including 4 centuries; 1 for Western Zone, 2 for Bathurst and 1 for St Pats Old Boys.

Carolyn Sheehan Trophy - Female Cricketer of the Year

Phoebe Johnston (Orange)



Phoebe represented NSW Country at the Under 16 Female National Championships this season where she scored 144 runs at 24 and picked up a couple of wickets.

Phoebe also played for the NSW Under 15 team at the School Sport Australia championships.

She was also part of the Western Zone Under 16 side that finished second to Newcastle in the Country Championships in Bathurst in December, as well as a member of the South West team at the Under 19 Country Championships.

On Saturdays Phoebe plied her trade for Kinross Wolaroi in the ODCA Seconds Grade competition. Then on Sundays she donned the Gordon colours in NSW Women’s Premier Cricket, in both Second Grade and Brewer Shield (Under 18s), on her way to racking up an impressive 49 matches for the season.

David Lester Trophy - Colts Cricketer of the Year

Blayde Burke (Bathurst)

Blayde Burke made his senior representative debut for Western Zone in his first season out of juniors.

He also represented NSW Country at both the Under 17 and Under 19 National Championships.

Blayde also represented Bathurst at Opens level, Central West in both Opens and Colts and managed to fit in a stint with UNSW in the NSW Premier Cricket's POidevin-Gray competition. Blayde was also part of the BOIDC premiership and Bonnor Cup winning St Pats Old Boys sides.

In a mammoth season, played 51 matches across all seasons, picking up 68 wickets with a best of 5/20.

Kellys Bakery Trophy - Junior Cricketer of the Year

Lochlan Shoemark (Bathurst)

Lochlan was Western's leading run scorer in the Bradman Cup this season, where he made 209 runs at 41.80. He also stood on top of the run-scorers list for the southern pool of the Under 15 Country Youth Championships with 232 runs at 46.40. Naturally he also represented Central West in Under 16s.

Playing for City Colts in the BOIDC competition when his school commitments permitted Shoemark made 2 half centuries from his 6 bats, with an undefeated 85 as his best in his 227 runs.

Carl Sharpe Memorial Award - Volunteer of the Year

Terry Ford (Mudgee)

Mudgee's Terry Ford is the recipient of the Carl Sharpe Memorial Award for this season. Terry has been Secretary of the Mudgee District Cricket Association for over ten seasons and continues to be heavily involved in Mudgee cricket.

Blayney didn't return to the Rod Hartas Trophy this season, and after unsuccessfully trying to cobble up a 4th team, we decided to play a full home and away season. As the final wouldn't fit into the season before the Western Zone Plate Final, the leading team at the end of the regular season qualified for that competition.

Mudgee topped the table and went on to play Cobar in the final of the Western Zone Plate competition. That put Mudgee into the Semi Finals of the Country Plate, where they were defeated by Cessnock.

Mudgee hosted Gulgong in the Rod Hartas Trophy Final and were successful in hoisting that trophy.
